NO SMOKING POLICY

SUMMARY OF PRINCIPAL CHANGES

General changes

Introduction of regulations relating to electronic cigarettes ('E-Cigarettes')¹

(Amendments to version 01.0, UPR HS06, are shown in italics.)

1 POLICY

- 1.1 Smoking and the use of E-cigarettes is prohibited in all buildings (including study bedrooms) and within **10** metres of any building owned, occupied or leased by the University.
- 1.2 Smoking *and the use of E-cigarettes* is prohibited in any vehicles owned by the University or hired for use on University business.
- 1.3 The University aims to become a no smoking campus and *to this end* will consult with interested parties.

2 SANCTIONS AND PENALTIES

- 2.1 Where staff or students breach these regulations, they will be requested to refrain from smoking or from using E-cigarettes. The University reserves the right to take disciplinary action against staff and students who fail to comply with such requests.
- 2.2 Where visitors breach these regulations, *they* will be requested to refrain from smoking *or from using E-cigarettes*. Failure to comply with *such* requests will lead to visitors being required to leave University premises or vehicles.
- 2.3 Any action taken by the University will be in addition to any sanction imposed as a result of legislation under the Health Act 2006.
