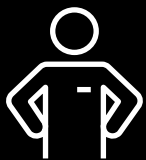

Located just a few miles outside of Hatfield, the historic city of St Albans has a thriving cultural life and is home to a wealth of bars, restaurants and theatrical venues.

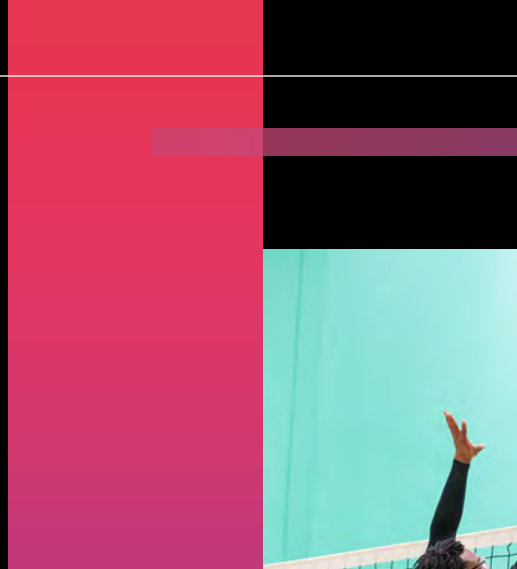
